Explanation of Financial Requirements

Anne Arundel Community College (AACC) reviews the financial documentation of F-1 students to insure the financial support is sufficient in order to issue an I-20. As part of the application process, all students are required to complete and return the Statement of Financial Resources Form with supporting documents. An international student at AACC will need to show official proof of sufficient funds to cover one year of tuition and fees, books and supplies, room and board, health insurance (required by state law), and personal expenses. Official proof of funding cannot be more than 6 months old at time of application.

International student with F-1 visa/status must demonstrate to the college and to the immigration officers that he/she has the sufficient funds to support his/her study for at least one academic year. Anne Arundel Community College (AACC) requires that applicant must show proof of financial support.

Acceptable financial documents are official bank statements of a regular checking or savings account with the total amount deposited for the past year and the present available balance. Bank statements must be issued within six months.

The prices listed above are estimates and are subject to change without notice. Students may be charged additional fees associated with their education level, choice of major, and/or course requirements.

PROOF OF FUNDING

Funding needs to be in liquid assets only. Please ensure that adequate funding will continue to be available from the same or equally dependable sources for subsequent years. You will be asked to show proof of funding at your visa interview or changing status to F-1 in the U.S. The proof can come from several different sources (personal, family, university or business); however, you must be sure to have supporting documents for each of the sources of funding.

Personal bank statements. If you will pay for your education and living expenses with your own personal funds, you must submit proof of funding that is in your name. The funds need to be on original bank letterhead stationery with a signature of the bank official in ink or a photocopy of the bank statement will need to be stamped by the issuing bank in original stamp ink and have a signature of a bank official in ink.

Be sure that your bank statement includes the following:

- Your Name, Account number and Date printed
- Shows available liquid funds
- Converted into US dollars or currency used must be indicated
- Written in English or with English translation

Acceptable financial statements are often but not limited to a printed online bank statement, paper bank statement or certificate of deposit from a bank. Stocks, salary to be received, retirement funds and land or property will not be accepted as proof of funding for study.

Sponsor (Family or Friend)

- **Sponsor from abroad:** Complete Affidavit of Support form and submit a copy of bank statement dated within the last six months. Proof of sponsor's income should be on the employer's letterhead, on income tax receipts and forms, or estimated by a bank if the sponsor is a self-employed business person.

Please note that the income of a company is not the income of the owner of the business and will not be accepted as proof of sponsor's income. We must have an official statement of the salary actually paid to the owner/sponsor and a letter from the bank certifying the sponsor is the account holder of the account.

- **Sponsor from United States:** In addition to bank statements, Form I-134 Affidavit of Support form must be submitted by U.S. residence sponsors.

Scholarship, Loans and Government sponsor:

Attach a signed copy of award letter or letter from agency certifying sponsorships or loans including the amount of funds and duration of scholarship.

Scholarship from AACC is very limited for international students, based on merit and need. Students may apply to the Financial Aid office after attending at least one semester at AACC. Student must consult with Financial Aid office first before applying. Bank statements cannot be dated more than six months prior to the date of application.

Dependents

If you wish to bring a family member as your dependent to the United States, he or she must submit a copy of proof of relationship to the dependent (e.g. marriage certificate for spouse and birth certificate for child). Additional \$5000 required per dependent. Free Room and Board U.S. sponsor who provide free room and board to the student must submit a notarized affidavit of support or Form I-134 with a copy of the lease or deed.

Housing

AACC does not provide housing for students.

Free Room and Board

U.S. sponsor who provide free room and board to the student must submit a notarized affidavit of support or Form I-134 with a copy of the lease or deed. AACC does not provide housing for students.

Payment Plan

AACC offer interest-free payment plan to all students. If student choose to pay less than the full amount due at the time of registration, student automatically enrolls in the college's payment plan.
