This transfer guide is intended for students pursuing an Associate of Science in Nursing at Anne Arundel Community College who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Nursing at Southern New Hampshire University. This transfer guide demonstrates how a student can meet both requirements for the associate and bachelor degrees.

## SAVINGS:

Anne Arundel County students can save up to **\$8,720.00** by starting their coursework at Anne Arundel Community College and then finishing up at Southern New Hampshire University {Based on tuition costs 2019-20}

AACC graduates are eligible for a 10% tuition reduction.

## SNHU NOTES:

NO EQUIVALENT\*\*active unencumbered Registered Nurse license are awarded 45 credits.

Students must earn a grade of C- or better for coursework to transfer.

Students may transfer up to 90 credits from AACC if students have not completed coursework at another college. Please consult SNHU advisor.
